Hans Dietmar Schweisgut, the former Ambassador of Austria to the European Union, who previously had been Austria's ambassador to Japan, is the new Ambassador of the EU Delegation to Japan.

He is the first ambassador to Japan to be appointed under the rules set out by the Lisbon Treaty setting up the European External Action Service.

Mr Schweisgut assumes his post at a pivotal time in Japan's history and in EU-Japan relations. Dealing with the current crisis and mapping out a **new bilateral framework** that will succeed the Action Plan for EU-Japan Cooperation are the current top priorities.

In his speech Mr. Schweisgut will address:

- issues of the future EU-Japan cooperation
- cooperation of the EU delegation with the EBC
- relevance of business topics for the Delegation's activities
